Chagigah Offerings on Yom Tov (Shalosh Regalim)

Who obligated	Males	Males	Men and women ¹
Animals used	Bird (young doves or turtle doves) or goat, sheep or bull	Domesticated animals only (goat, sheep or bull)	Domesticated animals only
When offered	First day of Festival		
Measure	 According to one's generosity but <i>Derabanan</i> , should not be worth less than 1 silver <i>maah</i>	 According to one's wealth but <i>Derabanan</i> , not less than 2 silver <i>maah</i>	No minimum measure. Brings animals or silver to <i>Yerushalayim</i> to purchase animals
Compensation	If did not offer on first day, should offer on one of remaining 7 days. (they are however only compensation for 1 st day)	If did not offer on first day, can offer on remaining 7 days	Must have the meat all days of festival
Overrides <i>Shabbat</i> or impurity	No (because their time is not fixed)	No	No
<i>Semichah</i> (leaning on animal with hands on its head)	Yes.	Yes	Yes

Besides these obligatory offerings, one may also offer sacrifices as one wishes or needs to do in *Chol HaMoed* i.e. on the Intermediate days of the Festival.

¹ It's unclear whether women are obligated to bring the sacrifice or whether they must simply rejoice, and if the latter, there is a further discussion whether it's their *personal* obligation or whether it's incumbent upon their husbands to make them happy.
