

Chibur – Transfer of Impurity in Mixtures of Food. (more remote connectives to Food)

Light bubbles on top of <i>trumah</i> food	✓		
Bubbles with some food inside them		✓	
<i>Charchur</i> (small protuberance from bread) became burnt		✓

Congeaed gel around <i>trumah</i> meat	✓		
Oil floating on <i>trumah</i> wine	✓

<i>Kodesh</i> items in grain form i.e. meal offering, frankincense coals of <i>Yom Kippur</i> (cherished nature causes entire amount to be considered single entity)		✓	
<i>Trumah</i> oil resting in <i>chulin</i>	✓		
<i>Chulin</i> cooked in <i>trumah</i> oil	✓		
Designated <i>challah</i> still joined to loaf. (<i>challah</i> is for Priest)		✓
