

## Combination of Liabilities

Ref: *Sefer Nezikin, Hilchot Gneivah, Chapter 3*

### CAPITAL AND FINANCIAL

If someone performed an act simultaneously deserving capital punishment and financial liability, financial liability falls away and he is only liable for the capital offence.

(Capital offences need a warning. So a warning would have to have been delivered prior to the act.)

### LASHES & FINANCIAL

Similarly, financial falls away and *malkot* (lashes) are applied. (A warning also would have to be given before *malkot*.)

If the two acts in above cases did not take place simultaneously, then two separate punishments would result.

Examples of simultaneous act. He set fire to colleagues grain heap (financial liability) on *Shabbat*. (Capital punishment for *Shabbat* violation – after having been warned.)
