Promissory note composed by borrower with <i>kinyan</i>	x	Borrower	Lien established on borrower property at time of <i>kinyan</i>
Deed of sale composed for a seller	x	Purchaser	Deed only for purchaser's benefit
Receipt composed for lender	x		Can't cause loss for borrower
Compose receipt for a woman even though husband not there (i.e. that she received her money re <i>ketubah</i> )	x		Husband can't suffer loss
Bill of divorce composed for man	x	Woman	Decision to divorce belongs only to the man
Legal documents for consecration (betrothal)	✓	Groom	Obligations of both families
Legal documents for marriage	✓	Groom	
Sharecropping agreements ( <i>arisut</i> )	✓	Sharecropper	
Business contracts	✓		
Choice of judges	✓	Share	I.e. when two litigants make up a court to judge them
Claim of litigants	✓	Share	The written recordings of each of the litigants in court
