

Hand-washing Mikvaot

Ref: *Sefer Taharah, Hilchot Mikvaot, Chapter 11*

 *Netilah* (washing) and *Tevilah* (immersing). *Derabanan*

Washing hands for ordinary food only need to be done once.

For *trumah* a second washing is needed.

It is our custom to wash even for ordinary food two or three times.
