Measuring vessels used in *Bet Hamikdash*

Dry measure

1 *Issaron* For *Menachot* (meal offering)

½ *Issaron* Meal offering of *Kohen Gadol* was divided into 2 every day

Wet measure

1 *hin* Was used only once by Moses to measure the oil for the anointing oil

½ *hin*

⅓ *hin* To measure *Nesachim* (wine libations)

¼ *hin*

1 *log* Oil for meal offering

Oil for each lamp in *Menorah*

½ *log* Water for *Sotah*

Oil for *Todah* (Thanksgiving offering)

¼ *log*

To divide oil for High Priest *Chavitin* offering

Oil for bread of *Nazir*

Water for purification of *metzora* (leper)

The anointing of Dry Vessels was anointed on inside only, whereas the Liquid Vessels were anointed inside and outside. Therefore, overflow on Dry Vessels is not consecrated, but with wet vessels, it is.
