<i>Shelamim</i>	Treated as <i>Shelamim</i> in all respects	Not sacrificed
<i>Temurah of Shelamim</i>	Treated as <i>Shelamim</i> in all respects	Not sacrificed
<i>Todah</i>	Treated as <i>Todah</i> except no bread	Not sacrificed
<i>Temurah of Todah</i>	Treated as <i>Todah</i> except no bread	Not sacrificed
<i>Chatat</i>	Consigned to death	
<i>Temurah of Chatat</i>	Consigned to death	
<i>Temurah of Asham</i>	Allowed to pasture until blemished and then proceeds used to purchase <i>Nedavah</i>	Same
<i>Asham</i> female	Pasture with mother until blemished and <i>Asham</i> purchased with proceeds	
<i>Temurah of Olah</i> male	Male is <i>Olah</i>	Male is <i>Olah</i> forever
<i>Olah</i> female	Even if male it should be allowed to pasture until blemished and then proceeds of sale used to bring an <i>Olah</i> .	
<i>Maaser</i>	Not offered. Allowed to pasture, become blemished and eaten. Belong to owner	Not offered
<i>Temurah of Maaser</i>	Not offered. Allowed to pasture, become blemished and eaten. Belong to owner.	Not offered
<i>Bechor</i>		
<i>Temurah of Bechor</i>	Not offered. Allowed to pasture until blemished and then eaten. Belong to Kohen	Not offered
<i>Pesach</i>		
<i>Temurah of Pesach</i>	Same as mother
