Did not burn it opposite <i>Kodesh Hakodashim</i>		✓
One of the 7 sprinklings of blood are lacking		✓
Removed blood from 'arrangement of wood' and then sprinkled		✓
Sprinkled even one of the 7 sprinklings of blood at night		✓
Slaughtered in different place where burnt		✓
Before burning, <i>Parah Adumah</i> was skinned and cut into pieces	✓	
Any slight part of its substance is missing, even its dung		✓
Left overnight without burning and then burnt following day	✓	
Priest burns Par without sanctifying hands and feet. (This can be done in <i>Azarah</i> or outside <i>Azarah</i>)		✓
Burning done with other woods and even straw	✓
