

Parking Areas for Loading etc for Neighbours

Reminder:

Pack on Courtyards



When a courtyard is shared by many homes, each home is given an area of courtyard in front of his house to be able to unload and load goods. i.e. **4 amah** in front of width of house. Anything extra between houses, if it is at least enough to give each neighbour minimum **4 square amah**, then one can force the others to divide.

A courtyard has to be at least **4 x 4 amah**.

Each house is given the width of the entrance (up to **10 amah wide** maximum) extending out for **4 amah**.

If one house has many entrances which are used, each entrance gets an area of **4 square amah**.
