

## Property of a Convert who dies without Children

Ref: *Sefer Kinyan, Hilchot Zechiyah Umatanah, Chapter 1*

	Acquires ownership
First person to take hold	✓
Neighbour has right to buy the property from the one who took hold	✗
If 2 fields separated by a boundary marker and manifestation of ownership is in one of the fields, even if he intended to take both	Only acquires the one field
Takes hold of the deed of sale within the estate	✗
Plunges spade into field in one place	✓ acquires whole field (only when boundaries are clear)
Boundary created which designates peah obligation e.g. river running through a field	✓ up to that boundary
Boundary created by <i>Shabbat</i> domains e.g. <i>karmelit</i> between 2 fields	✓ up to that boundary
Boundary created by ritual impurity e.g. a ritually impure area of a field is considered separate	✓ up to that boundary
Area of many fields without boundaries, and someone manifests ownership of one part	✓ Over all fields
