HOME, NON-KOSHER ANIMALS AND OTHER PROPERTY

If these are consecrated they are evaluated for their worth.

If redeemed by owner one must add $\frac{1}{5}$.

Funds used for improvements to Temple.

KOSHER ANIMALS

Unblemished animals once consecrated, cannot be released from being sacrificed on the *Mizbeach*.

The person who redeems, redeems for the sake of offering in Temple.

The funds received for the animal can be used to improve the Temple.

Males are sold for purpose of Burnt Offerings and females for the purpose of Peace Offerings.

Blemished animals can be redeemed and funds used for improvements to the Temple.

OTHER PROPERTY

Other items used on the *Mizbeach* like Wine, Oil, Fine flour, Doves – If they are consecrated, the funds should be used to purchase male animals for Burnt Offerings.

[(In comparison to an unblemished animal, there is the possibility that it could get a blemish and be redeemed. But with these items, they are never assessed for redeeming. Therefore, their funds must be allocated to the *Mizbeach* (Altar).]

If one dedicates to the *Mizbeach* (Altar), this means that proceeds should be used to purchase Offerings.
